Duties of Attorney General	<p>5. The Attorney General</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) is the official legal adviser to the Commissioner and the Government of the Northwest Territories;(b) is entrusted with the powers and charged with the duties which belong to the Attorney General and Solicitor General of England by law or usage, in so far as those powers and duties are applicable to	Attributions du procureur général

- the Territories, and also with the powers and duties which by the laws of Canada or of the Territories belong to the Attorney General for the Territories;
- (c) shall superintend and conduct all litigation for or against the Government of the Northwest Territories or any department of the Government of the Northwest Territories in respect of any subject within the authority or jurisdiction of the Legislature; and
- (d) shall carry out any other duties that may be referred to the Attorney General by the Commissioner in Executive Council.
