LIQUOR REGULATIONS, amendment

The Liquor Licensing Board, under section 11 of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, makes the following regulations:

1. The *Liquor Regulations*, R.R.N.W.T. 1990, c. L-34, as duplicated for Nunavut, are amended by these regulations.

2. The following is added after section 83:

83.1. (1) The maximum amount of liquor that a permit holder may purchase under an ordinary permit or a resale permit shall be determined according to Schedule D.

(2) On application by a permit holder, the Board may:

- (a) modify the maximum amount that may be purchased according to Schedule D; or
- (b) exempt the permit holder from the maximum according to Schedule D for a liquor purchase made (c)confirm the maximum amount that may be purchased according to Schedule D.
- (c) confirm the maximum amount that may be purchased according to Schedule D

(3) A decision of the Board under subsection (2) is final.

4. The following is added as Schedule D:

SCHEDULE D

The maximum amount of liquor that may be purchased by a permit holder under subsection 83.1(1) is calculated as follows:

- (a) two drinks per hour, each consisting of:
 - (i) 341 ml of beer, or
 - (ii) 43 ml of spirits, or
 - (iii) 142 ml of wine;
- (b) multiplied by the number of persons expected to be present at the event for which the liquor is intended;
- (c) multiplied by the number of hours for which the event is scheduled to take place.

5. These regulations apply according to their terms before they are published in the *Nunavut Gazette*.

6. These regulations come into force on the later of December 20, 2001 and the day they are registered with the Registrar of Regulations.
