LEGISLATION REGULATIONS, amendment

The Minister, under subsection 81(1) of the *Legislation Act*, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Legislation Regulations*.

- 1. These regulations amend the *Legislation Regulations*.
- 2. Section 1 is repealed and replaced by:

Content of the Nunavut Gazette

- 1. The *Nunavut Gazette* is comprised of one Part that contains
 - (a) with respect to each regulation required to be published under subsection 58(1) of the Act, the information referred to in paragraphs 58(1.1)(a) and (b) of the Act;
 - (b) instruments made by a Minister or the Commissioner under an enactment appointing any person to an office or position or revoking such an appointment, other than instruments referred to in subsection 29(10) of the Act; and
 - (c) notices and documents referred to in paragraphs 75(1)(c) and (d) and subsection 75(2) of the Act.

3. Section 2 is repealed and replaced by:

Editing the Gazette

2. (1) Subject to the direction of the Chief Legislative Counsel, the Territorial Printer may edit instruments published in the *Nunavut Gazette* in such a manner as, in the opinion of the Territorial Printer, gives the essential details of each instrument.

Exception

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to regulations required to be published under subsection 58(1) of the Act.

Handbook on editorial policies

- (3) The Territorial Printer may produce a handbook explaining the editorial policies relating to the *Nunavut Gazette* and may, with the approval of the Chief Legislative Counsel, publish the handbook in the *Nunavut Gazette* or on the Nunavut Legislation website.
- 4. These regulations come into force on the later of on July 3, 2025 and the day these regulations are registered by the Chief Legislative Counsel.

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
