OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS, amendment

The Minister, under section 25 of the *Safety Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.S-1, and every enabling power, makes the annexed amendments to the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulations*, Nu.Reg. R-003-2016.

- 1. These regulations amend the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations.
- 2. Section 1 is amended by repealing the definition of "medical professional" and adding the following definitions in alphabetical order:

"medical professional" means an individual who is a medical practitioner, a nurse practitioner or a registered nurse; (*professionnel de la santé*)

"nurse practitioner" means the following as defined in subsection 1(1) of the *Nursing Professions Act*:

- (a) a nurse practitioner, or
- (b) a temporary certificate holder (nurse practitioner); (infirmier praticien)

"registered nurse" means the following as defined in subsection 1(1) of the *Nursing Professions Act*:

- (a) a registered nurse, or
- (b) a temporary certificate holder (registered nurse); (infirmier autorisé)
- 3. (1) Paragraph 293(1)(a) is amended by replacing "medical professional" with "medical practitioner or nurse practitioner".
- (2) Subsection 293(2) is amended by replacing "they have been certified by a medical professional" with "they have been certified by a medical practitioner or nurse practitioner".
- 4. (1) Section 338 is amended by adding the following immediately preceding subsection (1):
- 338. (0.1) In this section, "nurse" means a person who is registered under the *Nursing Professions Act* and has a nursing designation as defined in subsection 1(1) of that Act.
 - (2) Subsection 338(4) is repealed and replaced by:
- (4) A person who has obtained information from a supplier or employer for the purposes of section 336 may communicate or disclose the information or cause it to be communicated or disclosed

- (a) to a medical professional who requests that information for the purpose of making a medical diagnosis of a person in an emergency; or
- (b) to a medical practitioner or nurse who requests that information for the purpose of rendering medical treatment to a person in an emergency.
- 5. Paragraph 349(1)(a) is amended by replacing "medical professional" with "medical practitioner or nurse practitioner".
- 6. Paragraph (h) of the definition of "health care facility" in section 463 is amended by replacing "Nursing Act" with "Nursing Professions Act".
