IQALUIT BEER AND WINE STORE REGULATIONS

The Commissioner of Nunavut, on the recommendation of the Minister, under sections 54 and 70 of the *Liquor Act* and every enabling power, makes the annexed *Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store Regulations*.

1. In these regulations, "Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store" means the liquor store established by the Minister in the city of Iqaluit for the purpose of selling beer and wine which may be carried away by retail customers.

2. The Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store is designated as a liquor store from which purchasers may personally carry away liquor.

3. The Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store may only be open between the hours of noon and 7 p.m., any day except holidays.

4. (1) Any adult may apply to the Minister for a customer account for the purpose of purchasing liquor at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store by providing his or her address and presenting photographic identification satisfactory to the Minister.

(2) The Minister shall issue and maintain a customer account for any adult who has made an application under subsection (1).

5. (1) Any person purchasing liquor at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store must have a customer account and present photographic identification satisfactory to the vendor.

(2) The vendor shall record each purchase made at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store in the appropriate customer account.

6. A person may purchase no more than the following amounts of liquor each calendar day that the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store is open:

- (a) 12 cans or bottles of beer containing a maximum of 500 ml per can or bottle; and
- (b) 2 bottles of wine containing a maximum of 1000 ml per bottle.

7. (1) No person shall purchase liquor at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store

- (a) without a customer account;
- (b) without photographic identification satisfactory to the vendor; or
- (c) in excess of the amounts described in section 6.

(2) No vendor shall sell liquor at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store to any person

- (a) who does not have a customer account;
- (b) who does not present photographic identification satisfactory to the vendor; or
- (c) whose customer account indicates that the person has, during the current calendar day, already purchased the amounts described in section 6.

Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store Regulations

(3) For greater certainty, no person shall purchase and no vendor shall sell any liquor other than beer and wine at the Iqaluit Beer and Wine Store.
