

## Notice of changes to the *Nunavut Gazette*

On July 3, 2025, *An Act to Amend the Legislation Act and Other Acts Respecting the Nunavut Gazette*, S.Nu. 2025,s.14, came into force. This Act removed the requirement for the following documents to be published in the *Nunavut Gazette*:

- The full text of regulations (previously Part II of the *Nunavut Gazette*)
- All notices under the *Archives Act*, the *Credit Union Act*, the *Emergency Measures Act*, the *Insurance Act*, the *Nunavummi Nangminiaqtunik Ikajuuti Implementation Act*, and the *Partnership Act*
- All notices issued by the Registrar of Corporations under the *Business Corporations Act*
- The full text of international regulations under the *International Interests in Mobile Aircraft Equipment Act*

As a result of these amendments, the *Legislation Regulations* were amended, with effect on July 14, 2025, to no longer require the *Nunavut Gazette* to be divided into Part I and Part II. Starting with the July 2025 edition, the *Nunavut Gazette* will be published as a single publication without separate parts. The visual appearance of the *Nunavut Gazette* has also been updated.

The *Nunavut Gazette* will continue to include a list of regulations that are published, as well as notices of international regulations under the *International Interests in Mobile Aircraft Equipment Act*.

Notices under the *Nunavummi Nangminiaqtunik Ikajuuti Implementation Act* will also be published on the Nunavut Legislation website.

Notices under the *Credit Union Act* and the *Partnership Act*, and notices issued by the Registrar of Corporations under the *Business Corporations Act* will be published on the website of Legal Registries Division: <https://nunavutlegalregistries.ca/>.

Notices under the *Emergency Measures Act* will be published on a Government of Nunavut website.

Notices under the *Insurance Act* may be published in a manner determined by the Superintendent of Insurance.

Notices under the *Archives Act* will no longer be published.

These amendments do not affect the publication of other notices in the *Nunavut Gazette*, nor the publication of appointments and revocations.
