- In the English version, the term "he or she", "his or her", "him or her" and "himself or herself" have been changed to "they", "their", "them", and "themselves" respectively and other related words have been consequently changed for grammatical agreement.
- In the French version, the grammatical forms of the word “Inuit” have been changed to reflect number, gender and agreement between nouns and adjectives.
