In the September 18, 2025 consolidation of the *Official Languages Act*,

- changes were made to section headings to reflect amendments that came into force on September 18, 2025.
- in the English version, the term "his or her" has been changed to "their".

The changes in the following table were made in the July 1, 2021 consolidation of the *Official Languages Act*:

- Subsection 16(6) that was added by S.Nu. 2017,c.29,s.5(2) has been renumbered as subsection 16(7).
- Subsection 20.1(4) that was added by S.Nu. 2017,c.29,s.5(3) has been renumbered as subsection 20.1(3).
- In the French version, the grammatical forms of the word “Inuit” have been changed to reflect number, gender and agreement between nouns and adjectives.

Disclaimer: the July 1, 2021 consolidation of the *Official Languages Act* is based on earlier, non-official consolidations. Legislation Division has maintained record of all changes made in the

non-official consolidations over time, and all the recorded changes are reflected in the table above. However, it is not possible to verify that every single change in the existing non-official consolidation was duly recorded.
